### PIEDMONT

**Bruno Rocca Barbaresco, 2000** 82  
100% Nebbiolo. Licorice, tobacco, and white truffle with long and buttery tannins.

**L'Illuminata Barolo Tebavio, 2003** 90  
100% Nebbiolo. Hints of cinnamon, clove, vanilla, and cherry with a long, floral finish.

**Marchesi di Barolo Barbera Monferrato, 2004** 8 30  
100% Barbera. Wild berry and touches of vanilla with a warm, well-balanced finish.

### VENETO

**Bertani Amarone, 1999** 125  
70% Corvina Veronese, 25% Rondinella, 5% Molinara. Cherry, red berry, and vanilla with a dry, full-bodied finish.

### TUSCANY

**Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva Badia a Pasignano, 2001** 65  
100% Sangiovese. Cherry, chocolate, and vanilla flavor with earth tones.

**Baroncini Morellino di Scansano, 2005** 8 30  
Blend of Morellino (Sangiovese), Cilieggiolo, and Alicante. Wildberry and blueberry with soft tannins.

**La Fuga Brunello di Montalcino, 2001** 97  
100% Sangiovese Grotto. Red berry offset by leather and incense.

**Nozzole Il Pareto, 2001** 115  
100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Black currant, leather, vanilla, with jammy fruit.

**Petra Toscana, 2003** 65  
Blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon. Red fruit, jam, vanilla, and cocoa.

**San Guido Guidalberto, 2005** 77  
45% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot, 10% Sangiovese. Crisp fruit with subtle oak and medium tannins.

**Santa Martina Toscana, 2005** 8.5 32  
40% Sangiovese, 20% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Syrah. Wild berry with a spicy finish.

**Sette Ponti Crognolo, 2004** 52  
90% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot. Currant, plum, blackberry, cedar and cherry.

**Solo Maremma Micante, 2004** 38  
70% Sangiovese, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon. Ripe black cherry and berry, medium body with a fruity finish.

**Toscolo Chianti Classico, 2005** 11 42  
95% Sangiovese, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon. Rich and smoky with abundant fruit.

### UMBRIA

**Falesco Vitiano, 2005** 8.5 32  
One-third Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Sangiovese. Plum, berry, and chocolate.

### CAMPANIA

**Feudi di San Gregorio Aglianico Rubrato, 2004** 11 42  
100% Aglianico. Red berry and spice with a soft, smooth finish.

### SARDINIA

**Agricola Punica Barrua, 2003** 75  
85% Carignano, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Merlot. Blackberry, black plum, herbs and spices with soft tannins and a long finish.

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### DELLE VENEZIE

**Primaterra Pinot Grigio, 2006** 7.5 28  
100% Pinot Grigio. Mineral and lemon with a medium-bodied palate.

### FRIULI

**Borgo M Pinot Grigio, 2006** 8.5 32  
100% Pinot Grigio. Lemon and mineral flavors, medium bodied, crisp finish.

### PIEDMONT

**Bruno Rocca Chardonnay, 2004** 62  
100% Chardonnay. Acacia honey and tropical fruits with toasted almond and vanilla.

**Michele Chiarlo Gavi, 2005** 10 38  
100% Cortese. Delicate pear and white fruit with notes of almond.

**Villa Sparina Montej, 2006** 30  
Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Muller-Thurgau. Grapefruit, honey, and a light, spicy cedar note.

### LOMBARDY

**Contadi Castaldi Franciacorta Rosé, NV** 49  
100% Pinot Nero. A sparkling wine with red fruit, cherry, and raspberry.

### VENETO

**Anselmi San Vincenzo, 2006** 8.5 32  
80% Garganega, 15% Chardonnay, 5% Trebbiano. Mineral, apple, banana, and lemon.

### UMBRIA

**Antinori Orvieto Classico Campogrande, 2006** 8.5 32  
Classic Orvieto blend with mineral and bright fruit and an acidic finish.

### CAMPANIA

**Feudi di San Gregorio Greco di Tufo, 2006** 49  
100% Greco di Tufo. Apricot, apple, fern, and mint with a long, fruity finish.
